

CARRY OVER PUBLIC HEARING

At a carry over public hearing held at the Town Hall in the Town of Copake, New York the following were present Supervisor Valentino, Councilperson Ritchie, Councilperson Gabaccia, Councilperson Miller, and Councilperson Sacks.

Supervisor Valentino opened the meeting at 5:00 pm with 4 people present.

The purpose of the hearing is to review the preliminary budget for the year 2007.

Supervisor Valentino said they will raise the sales and mortgage revenue reduced the 5130.2 to \$25,000.00 raise 5142.1 to \$160,000.00.
