

**Copake Comprehensive Plan Committee
Final Report to the Public- September 19, 2011**

At their meeting on September 8, 2011, by a unanimous vote, the Town Board passed a resolution to adopt the Comprehensive Plan as proposed. Before voting, the Board heard comment during a Public Hearing.

The adoption of the Plan was the culmination of over three years work by the Committee. During the past month, the proposed Plan had been approved by the Columbia County Planning Board.

The Committee's work is now complete, and implementation of the Plan will depend upon initiatives to be pursued by the Town. The actions proposed by the Plan are far-reaching and involve not just possible changes to zoning, but many other aspects of the Town as well.

The proposed Comprehensive Plan is available online at www.copake.org/. Also available online is the Appendix, which is 426 pages in length and includes the Survey and results, census information, various studies and reports relied upon by the Committee, summaries of Stakeholder Meetings, reports from the Conservation Resources Committee and the Copake Economic Advisory Board and the Community Profile and Maps. Both the Plan and Appendix can be downloaded.

Copies of the Plan are also available for review at the Roeliff Jansen Community Library and the Town Hall. (The Appendix is not at the Library but can be reviewed at the Town Hall.) A large-print copy of the Plan can be reviewed at the Town Hall.
